RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. MILCOPEX is a World Series of Philately competitive exhibition open to any and all collectors regardless of place of residence. The exhibitor winning the MILCOPEX Grand Award is eligible to enter the APS Champion of Champions competition in August, 2006.
- 2. Every exhibit shall be the bonafide property of the exhibitor. Material with dual or corporate ownership is respectfully declined.
- 3. OWNERS MUST PROVIDE THEIR OWN INSURANCE. All reasonable precautions will be taken for the safety of the exhibits. However, no responsibility shall attach to MILCOPEX, the Four Points by Sheraton Milwaukee Airport, or their officers, members or employees for any loss or damage whatsoever.
- 4. Frames are vertical AMERIPEX type and will hold 16 8½ x 11" pages. Protective page covers are required, and each exhibit page must bear progressive numbers on the reverse side to indicate the order in which the pages are to be mounted.
- 5. All exhibits must be entered by Section. The Exhibit Committee reserves the right to reject or reclassify any exhibit.
- 6. Open and Display Class Exhibit entry fees are \$8.00 per frame, and One Frame Exhibits are \$15.00. There is no charge for Youth Exhibits. Make remittances payable to the **Milwaukee Philatelic Society, Inc**.
- 7. FRAME LIMIT: An exhibitor may enter more than one exhibit providing an entry form is submitted for each entry. The maximum number of frames per exhibit is ten (youth four). Youth and one frame exhibits are not eligible for the Grand or Reserve Grand Awards. Collectors through age eighteen may exhibit in the Youth Section.
- 8. All entries must be made on the official entry form and accompanied by the correct fees. <u>Signing of entry form denotes acceptance of all rules and regulations</u>. Acknowledgment of entry form does not signify acceptance in exhibition.
- 9. Entries will be reviewed and notification of acceptance will be made after the deadline for accepting entries. The Milwaukee Philatelic Society reserves the right to refuse any exhibit. All fees will be refunded in case of non-acceptance.
- 10. The closing date for entries will be July 1, 2005, or when all frames are filled.
- 11. Eight copies of your TITLE PAGE and/or SYNOPSIS for use by the Judges and Apprentices are due by July 1, 2005.
- 12. Exhibitors will be notified of where and when to send exhibits to be submitted by mail.

- 13. Exhibits must be forwarded prepaid. Exhibits will be returned promptly after closing of the exhibit. Instructions for the return of the Exhibit, along with adequate postage and wrapping costs must accompany the entry form. No exhibit will be returned until prepayment of postage and wrapping is made. If insufficient funds are provided to return exhibits as specified, exhibits will be returned by insured parcel post mail.
- 14. Personally delivered exhibits will be received by the Exhibition Committee at the Exhibition on September 15, 2005. Exhibitors will be notified of when that day to deliver their exhibits for mounting.
- 15. Those personally calling for exhibits may receive them on Sunday, September 18, 2005, between 4:30 p.m. and 6:00 p.m. No exhibit will be released until 4:30 p.m. on Sunday, September 18, 2005. No exhibit will be removed until the exhibit area is cleared of all visitors. Exhibitors must wait in the reception area until their numbers are called if they are dismounting their own exhibits, and must sign a receipt at the time of exhibit pickup.
- 16. Names will be listed in the exhibition program unless the exhibitor chooses to remain anonymous for that purpose. No pseudonyms are permitted.
- 17. Exhibitors may discuss arrangements by telephone with Robert Henak at (414) 351-1519 or by email at henak@execpc.com.
- 18. Exhibit Section I, Novice, is reserved for Milwaukee Philatelic Society members who have never exhibited at a National Exhibition.
- 19. The exhibits will be judged by American Philatelic Society accredited judges whose decisions will be final. Each exhibit will be judged on its own merits on an open show basis. Exhibitors desiring a critique of their exhibit should arrange to attend personally or have a proxy attend the APS Judging Seminar and Critique on Saturday, September 17, 2005.
- 20. The Exhibition Committee will place at the disposal of the judges a sufficient number of MILCOPEX Gold, Vermeil, Silver, Silver-Bronze, and Bronze Awards. No limitation is placed on these awards and they will be awarded without regard to section.
- 21. The Exhibition Committee in their sole and absolute discretion shall decide any and all questions that may arise concerning the Exhibition and not provided for by these rules and regulations.
