Organized Nov. 5, 1899 - 109 Years of Philately in Milwaukee

The Milwaukee Philatelic Society, Inc. will hold the new and revised MILCOPEX on September 12, 13, and 14, 2008 in Bergstrom Hall at Mount Mary College at 2900 N. Menomonee River Parkway in Milwaukee, Wisconsin. The show will be held in the elegant Alumnae Dining Room with easy access from U.S. Highway 45, free parking, and convenient entrance to the show room floor. A map and directions will be mailed to participating dealers prior to the show.

MILCOPEX 2008 is an American Philatelic Society Champion of Champions Exhibition.

The Milwaukee Philatelic Society, Inc., will exercise reasonable care for the protection of the dealer, his representative and his merchandise. Non-show hour security will be provided; however, the officers and members of the Milwaukee Philatelic Society, Inc., the MILCOPEX 2008 Committee, and Mount Mary College will not be responsible for any losses incurred during MILCOPEX 2008.

Dealers may set up on Thursday, September 11 from 8:00 P.M. until 10:00 P.M, and again on Friday, September 12 from 7:00 A.M. until 10:00 A.M. at which time the show will open. 115 Volt Electricity will be available but you must bring a 25 foot extension cord as outlets are limited and located only on the perimeter of the room.. If electricity is required please indicate this on the line for "Special Instructions or Requirements" on the dealer application form.

Your signature on the enclosed application signifies that you accept all MILCOPEX 2008 rules and will abide by them. The application together with payment, should be mailed to the Bourse Chairman. Please keep this sheet for your records. An acceptance notice confirming your table assignment will be mailed to you promptly after your application and payment are received.

MILCOPEX 2008 RULES

- 1.) No sales are permitted outside of the confines of your table. Merchandise, catalogs, literature, etc., may not be distributed outside of your booth area. This material, with the approval of the Bourse Chairman, may be placed on the Milwaukee Philatelic Society literature tables, however.
- 2.) No dealer may sublet part of his table or area unless approved by the Bourse Chairman in advance. Dealers must clear the area on Sunday, September 14, no later than 6:30 P.M.
- 3.) In the event that a dealer can not attend MILCOPEX 2008 as scheduled, the dealer must notify the Bourse Chairman as soon as possible. No refunds will be given unless a replacement can be found. No refund will be made for tables canceled less than 72 hours before MILCOPEX 2008.
- 4.) Dealers must check in with the Bourse Chairman at the time of set-up.
- 5.) Those dealers who participated in MILCOPEX 2007 will be given one week advance opportunity to once again secure a table at MILCOPEX 2008. Any unclaimed or remaining tables after the one week time period will be awarded on a first come basis. Applications received, with fees accompanying them, and approved by the Bourse Chairman, will secure a table for the dealer. Acceptance will be promptly acknowledged.
